

POLI CONCLAVE

Conclave, from the Latin con “with” and clavis “key”, “locked room”. It is the chamber where the cardinals of the catholic Church gather when electing the new pope, locked with a key. Like the barrels where our whisky ages for long years.

Conclave is a whisky with a daring and vibrant aroma, obtained from pure peated and unpeated barley malt, distilled separately. The new make spirits thus obtained rest in medium toasted white oak barrels, used and reconditioned, in order to extract only the softest tannins from the pores of the wood. After five years of ageing, the single barrels are joined together, to obtain a whisky with a unique character.
